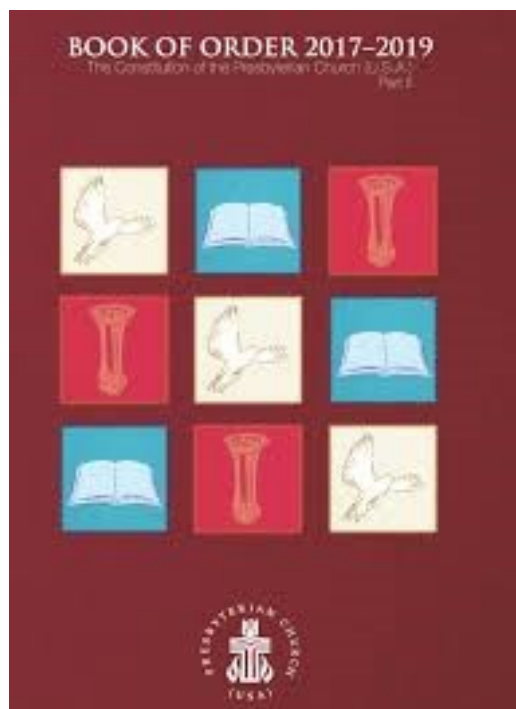
Hanging of the Greens

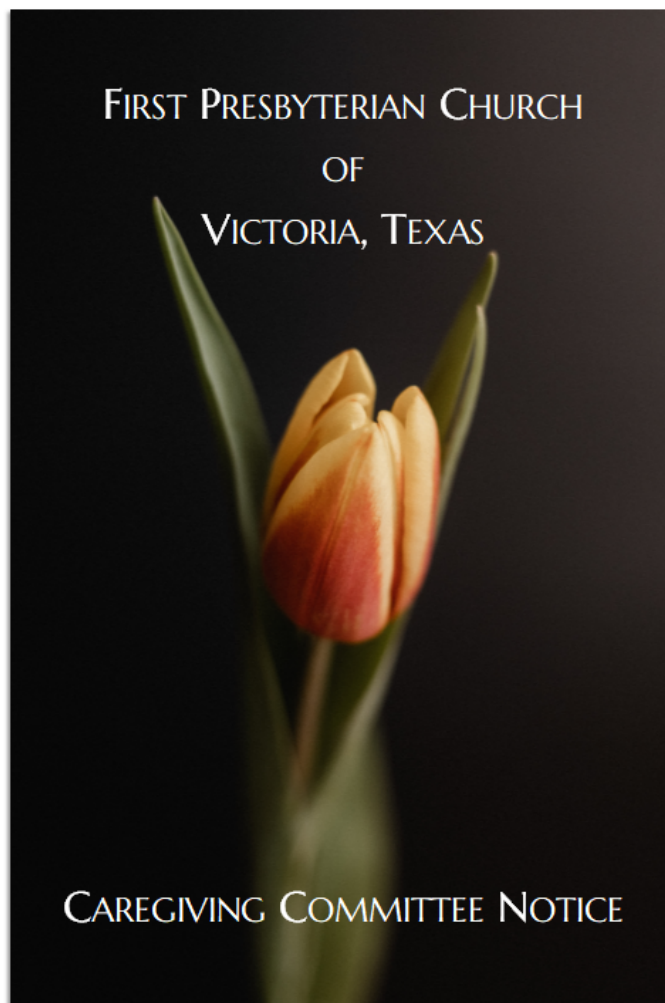
Nellie Hudson Adult Sunday School
