This year First Presbyterian Church is participating in an Angel Tree Christmas project to benefit children in the Kinship Program of the

Texas Department of Family and Protective Services.

Children in the Kinship Program have been removed from their homes by Child Protective Services and are being cared for by family members.

In most cases, the children are living with grandparents, or extended family members who are raising their own children.

Many of these families have limited resources but have "stepped up" to care for additional children who would otherwise be placed in foster care.

The Texas Department of Family and Protective Services Kinship unit has provided the names of approximately 30 – 35 area children from infancy to 17 years of age.


Our amazing congregation has already selected over 30 of the names provided, meaning we only need 4 to 5 more volunteers to fill the reasonable "wish lists" of children who find themselves in difficult circumstances.

The deadline for contributions is this Sunday, **December 15, 2019**.

Church members can also participate by providing wrapping paper, tape, etc.; by wrapping and labeling gifts; or by purchasing gift cards which will be used to assist the families who are providing care.

The decorations in the stores and in the public squares, the worship services in our church, the opportunities for family reunions and good times together—all of these sensations and memories of happy occasions, past and present, speak to a season of joy and celebration.

With all my heart, I hope this is true for you as we enter the Advent Season and celebrate Christmas.

Alas, however, this is not always so for all. For many, the holidays are a difficult time,

and the pressure to be festive and meet what are, or what we perceive to be, the expectations of others can be overwhelming.

For those who find themselves in places of sadness, pain, loneliness, or darkness,
I pray that you understand you are not alone.

Common sense, personal experience, and mental health
professionals make us aware that the Christmas Holidays
do not automatically banish reasons for feeling sad or lonely.

If you are feeling this way, then, as you read this note,
I hope you also sense that you are surrounded by a church family
that is supportive and caring about you as a child of God.

And may we, as members of that church family, be sensitive and understanding towards
our sisters and brothers who may be experiencing their first Christmas
without a loved one or for whom Christmas does not always hold
the happy memories that are stereotyped in
the merchandising and advertising of the culture that surrounds us.

For all of us, I pray we find time for ourselves rather than trying to be what others expect us to be.

I pray we do not try to pretend to have emotions we believe we are "supposed to be feeling" rather than relying on our sovereign God to comfort and support us as we experience our emotions as they are.

If this season becomes challenging for you, or if you just need a sympathetic ear or a sincere word of encouragement, please feel free to call on me at any time.

Speak to me after church, in the halls, or in my office, or simply call me to arrange a visit.

Let us all share our love for one another as God has shared, in Jesus Christ, his love for us.
