During our Session meeting yesterday evening (August 11, 2020), the Elders were discussing various and sundry things about the worship services we have been streaming now for over 20 weeks, and one Elder asked why we were no longer singing the *Doxology* during worship. Your Pastor replied that, because we cannot pass the offering plates among a congregation that is not present, the "tithes and offerings portion" of our "normal liturgy" had simply been eliminated.

With, I am sure, the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, one of our Elders then said, "Well, even if we can't pass the plate, we can still thank God for the many blessings we have received-- even in this time of a terrible pandemic." How wise; how true! Just because we no longer have a "collection" during our virtual worship services, that does not mean we should suspend thanking God for the love, mercy, and blessings we receive every day. Sometimes theology is practiced at a Session meeting, even when we don't call it that!

During our worship service for August 16, 2020 and continuing thereafter, watch for the addition to our liturgy of a Prayer of Thanksgiving, followed by the always appropriate *Doxology*.


DID YOU SEE THE ARTICLE ABOUT FPC

Also within our community, the Victoria 2020 Census Complete Count Committee is working hard to encourage everyone in Victoria County and the surrounding area to be counted in the 2020 Census. The U.S. Census Bureau estimates that the population of Texas was undercounted by almost 1% in the 2010 Census. This may not sound like much, but the failure to identify every individual in our state resulted in a cumulative loss of nearly \$300 million annually in federal funds to Texas during the past decade, or \$1,161 per person missed in the census count.

If you have not completed your census form, please do so promptly. Equally important, if you know someone who has been negletful or suspicious of the census,

please encourage them to overcome their unfounded apprehensions and complete their census form. Every taxpayer in Victoria, and of course in Texas, has a vested social and financial interest in making sure that everyone in our community and in our state is accurately counted in the current census.

While all of this is going on, we are still searching for a camera person to help us operate our new camera equipment which we obtained with a grant from Mission Presbytery. We need someone to be available for two hours on the Saturdays when we record our worship services and, once the pandemic has passed, for two hours

on the Sundays when we gather again in the Sanctuary. Additionally, a few additional hours are necessary to process and upload each video from our new equipment to the Internet.
