This Sunday is World Communion Sunday. In recognition of the fact that we will be participating in this sacrament with our Christian sisters and brothers around the world, we will decorate our altar with a multitude of breads—breads as diverse as God's people around the world who bring their own unique style to preparing this staple of life.

We will also celebrate the 180th anniversary of the founding of First Presbyterian Church of Victoria, Texas (October 2, 1841). For eighteen decades, FPC has been spreading the Gospel in the Crossroads area! Let us rejoice over the host of so many faithful saints before us who selflessly kept the flame of faith ablaze and who have made it possible for us to worship as we do today.

Finally, during our service of music we will dedicate our splendid post-Hurricane Harvey organ to the glory of God and in service to the music ministry of this church. We will feature organ anthems and other special music in honor of the occasion. What a right and proper way to thank God for the many blessings he offers us through music!

Our Scripture readings for next Sunday, the Twenty-second Sunday after Pentecost, are: Proverbs 150; and Colossians 3:14-17. The time that we ordinarily devote to a sermon during which the Word is proclaimed will, on this occasion, be given over to the celebration and dedication of our new organ. 


# TO VCAM REQUESTS REMAINS GENEROUS!


