For those who receive this newsletter by mail, we will also enclose a printed copy of the worship bulletin for next Sunday's worship service.



"Do It Afraid: Embracing Courage in the Face of Fear," by Joyce Meyer is the book chosen by Leila Galvan and a group of her colleagues who will be joining us. Books and study guides can be purchased at H-E-B and Hobby Lobby and online at Amazon for around \$10 each.

In "Do It Afraid," Ms. Meyer argues powerfully that you do not have to allow fear to dictate your decisions or determine what you will or will not do.
