Pastor's Notes

The Preface to the Presbyterian Hymnbook of 1955 (universally known among Presbyterians as "The Red Hymnal") contains this observation:

The Christian religion is a singing faith, and thus stands in striking contrast to most of the great religions of [humanity]. From the dawn of creation, when 'the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy" [Job 38:7], psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs have been vehicles of the faith, the aspiration, and the joy of God's people. The corporate praise and choral prayer of a worshipping congregation have been characteristic expressions of its response to divine grace."

As we make a joyful noise to the LORD this morning, as we worship Him with gladness, and as we come into His presence with singing, let us enjoy ourselves mightily, knowing that that the LORD is God, it is He that made us, and we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture (Psalm 100).
