Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these". Matt 19:14


Do not misuse God's name - the 3rd commandment (well, at least it's how we say it in 'kid language'). In order to convey the meaning of this 'rule' we




ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING RESUMES THIS FRIDAY, AUGUST 18, 2023, AT 10:00 A.M.
