
Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these". Matt 19:14


#### **CHRISTIAN EDUCATION**




# PERIODIC FPC FINANCIAL REPORT TO THE CONGREGATION (JANUARY 1 THROUGH JULY 31, 2023)

I am happy to report that, through the first seven months of 2023, church revenue exceeded church expenses by \$5,796. As always, we must remain cautious even in the midst of good news. Nevertheless, this surplus is particularly encouraging, not only by its amount, but also by the fact that it indicates our members and friends have faithfully maintained their generous level of giving even over the normally sleepy summer months.

This is also encouraging news in the midst of our 2024 Stewardship Campaign. It is reassuring for us to see that the hard-earned money we pledge to this church is carefully monitored and wisely spent. You may be sure that the monitoring and other fiscal practices that have been implemented by Treasurer Dawn Neel, our Finance Committee, and our Session keep us watchful and financially responsible every month of the year.
