"Hearts, Not Hierarchy"

"Now the boy Samuel was ministering to the Lord under Eli. The word of the Lord was rare in those days; visons were not widespread."

1 Samuel 3:1-10

Repeatedly, Scripture shows us that God's not impressed with our positions, power, or titles. God looks beyond the titles and accolades that the world bestows to see our hearts. Samuel is an apprentice to Eli, the high priest, yet God chooses Samuel to relay a critical and ultimately heartbreaking prophecy to Eli. God upended the expected order of the rank of priesthood.
